Assemble at Change International Airport for your flight to Melbourne.

DAY 02: MELBOURNE

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel base on seat-in coach for your overnight stay. Rest of the day free at leisure. Please reconfirm with our local representative on your pick-up time for your daily itineraries

DAY 03: MELBOURNE (Complimentary Tour)

(Breakfast)

Today, you will enjoy either one of the following Complimentary Tour of your choice:

1) Marvellous Melbourne City Sights (M1) {Dep. 8.30pm Ret .12.15pm}

Discover all the charms of elegant and contemporary Melbourne. Cross the West Gate Bridge for amazing city views and observe the Yarra River's bustling. See Captain Cook's Cottage, Queen Victoria Market, Fitzroy Gardens and Albert Park, home to the Australian Formula One Grand Prix. Visit the history Shrine of Remembrance and stroll along Southbank's waterfront precinct. This city has it all – discover it for yourself.



2) City Sights and Dandenong Ranges (M2) {Dep. 1.30pm Ret. 5.30pm}

Discover contrasts of Melbourne: bushland and city sights Dominating Melbourne's eastern horizon, the blue hue of the Dandenong Ranges promises visitors picturesque mountainside forest, cool fern gullies, charming villages and breathtaking views. Immerse yourself in the natural beauty and delightful birdlife of Sherbrooke Forest. Enjoy city highlights before traveling east to the Dandenong Ranges. See the highlights of the city of Melbourne. Travel past Flinders Street Station's Paul's Cathedral, Old Melbourne Gaol and Queen Victoria Market. See Chinatown, the Flagstaff and Fitzroy Gardens and Kings Domain. Stop for a photo opportunity at Shrine of Remembrance. Travel through the trendy suburbs of South Yarra and Toorak. Look out for kookaburras and bell birds, colourful crimson rosella and king parrots. Hand feed the colourful rosella birds inhabiting Sherbrooke Forest(seed provided). Enjoy the meandering drive that leads through lush forest of tall trees and hilltop villages. Relish the spectacular vista from the Dandenongs Lookout.



3) Great Ocean Road (M4+W) {Dep. 8.30am Ret 5.30pm}

Enjoy one of the world's great coastal drives with dramatic scenery, striking contrasts and magnificent vistas around every corner. Admire views of the Melbourne skyline and Port Phillip Bay from the West Gate Bridge. See the pretty seaside town of Lorne and the surfacing mecca of Torquay, home to some of Victoria's magnificent surf beaches, including the world-famous Bells Beach which hosts the Esther Surfacing Classic and offer year-round waves. Discover the legends of the 'The Shipwreck Coast' at Port Campbell National Park. See the spectacular **Twelve Apostles**, sandstone pillars that face the raging **Southern Ocean**, as well as **Loch Ard Gorge** and the famous rocky span of London Bridge.



DAY 04: MELBOURNE

(Breakfast)

Today, you will enjoy either one of the following pre-selected tour of your choice:

1) Philip Island Penguins and Wildlife (M10) {Dep. 1.30pm Ret * approx 10.30pm}

Visit Warrook Cattle Farm, a working cattle property, and enjoy the opportunity to feed kangaroos and other farm animals. At Phillip Island visit the Koala Conservation Centre and see koalas along an elevated boardwalk. View the Nobbies, home to one of Australia's largest fur seal populations. See the seaside town of Cowes and the Visitors Information Centre. At dusk, enjoy the "Penguin Parade" and see penguins make their way to their burrows.

2) Yarra Valley Wineries and Puffing Billy (M15) {Dep. 8.30am Ret 5.30pm}

Journey into the heart of picturesque wine country and ride Australia's oldest steam train before arriving at a winery (Optional Lunch at own expenses). Marvel at the spectacular views and lush rainforest setting of Sherbrooke Forest, home to native birds whose song fill the air as you ride aboard the Puffing Billy Steam Train. This historic takes you through the towering ash trees and lush fern gullies. Enjoy a spit roast lunch (Optional) at Fergusson Winery, then sample local wines at Coldstream Hills before taking a winemarketing tour of the highly regarded Domaine Chandon, also sampling local cheeses.



3) Sovereign Hill & Historic Ballarat Wildlife Park (M3+W) {Dep. 8.20am Ret 5.30pm}

Visit the Ballarat Wildlife Park and discover the unique creatures of the Australian bush. Get as close as you dare to a crocodile at a feeding session, see Tasmanian devils, wallabies, giant turtles, emus. Explore Ballarat, the glorious legacy that gold bestowed on this colonial town is still evident in the respectfully restored buildings and atmosphere of proud Ballarat. Sovereign Hill in Ballarat is a perfectly re-created example of Gold rush life during Victoria's Golden era. Explore the daily ritual of this Gold town and stroll the main street to visit with goldsmiths, crafts people, traders, soldiers and the like. Find your own fortune whilst panning for gold in the stream, go "underground" to the fascinating Gold mine and museum or ride the stage-coach through the village. Exhibits and displays unfold before you as you stroll through this bustling pioneer township. Have a chat to the gentle town folk and be captivated by the friendly outlook on their 1850s daily life.



4) Warrook Cattle farm & Phillip Island Penguins Parade (M82) {Dep. 10.00am Ret 11.30pm}

As our luxury coach departs Melbourne, sit back and relax as we make our way to our first port of call. Spend time at Warrook Station Farm - Cattle, lambs, kangaroos and homestead country cooking plus Warrook is a classic family owned station property running over 150 head of cattle and over 900 lambs. You will enjoy an insider look at typical station life and all the daily action. Experience genuine Australian country hospitality at Warrook Farm. Feed the kangaroos, wombats and baby farm animals. Watch the sheep dogs run through their paces as they muster sheep. Take a hay ride around the farm or help milk the cows in the dairy. "Click go the shears", during the interesting sheep shearing demonstration out in the shed or barn. Next we visit the Koala Conservation Centre and learn about these cuddly creatures. Stroll along the elevated boardwalks to view the koalas in their natural habitat. See a spring of fur seals at the Nobbies, on the dramatic southern coastline. Top this outdoor day with an evening visit to Phillip Island. Browse through the educational Phillip Island Visitors Information Centre. Take your place in special viewing stands to watch the daily evening ritual of the wild little penguins and watch the little penguin parade at dusk, as they exit the surf and waddle to their nests. Note: Nobbies viewing is seasonal and dependant on daylight hours.
