DAY 01: SINGAPORE ✈ SYDNEY

(Meals-On-Board)

Assemble at Changi International Airport for your flight to Sydney.

DAY 02: SYDNEY

(No Meal)

Upon arrival, meet by our representative for your seat-in-coach transfer to your hotel. You will proceed for your Sydney City Tour

1) Downtown Sydney, Bondi and Kings Cross (S3) {Dep. 2.15pm Ret 05.45pm}

Your afternoon tour captures the essence of Sydney. See Sydney's major highlights, including the Botanic Gardens, before wandering along Bondi Beach. See the city's downtown precincts, the historic Rock area, vibrant Kings Criss, sandy white eastern beaches and affluent harbourside suburbs in just one afternoon. Optional - Add a luncheon cruise and enjoy views of Sydney's renowned sights. Watch the Harbour Bridge and Opera House glide by as you enjoy an idyllic lunchtime on Sydney Harbour.



DAY 03: SYDNEY

(Breakfast)

Today, you will enjoy either one of the following pre-selected tour of your choice :



1) Port Stephens and Nelson Bay Adventure (S37) {Dep. 8.30am Ret 07.15pm} (Dep : Every Mon, Wed, Fri & Sun)

Encounter an unspoilt and diverse blue water paradise at coastal town of Port Stephens, known as a wildlife haven thanks to the presence of around 160 bottle-nosed dolphins which have permanent residence here. To begin the day, you'll journey over the Hawkesbury River and stop at the Australia Reptile Park to see a number of our native reptiles up close. Re-boarding you coach, you'll then arrive at the pristine Pot Stephens region. Experience the vast desert wilderness as well as a range of inspiring environmental and historical sights. Board a luxury cruise in search of pods of bottle-nosed dolphins and other aquatic wildlife, delighting in the sight of wild dolphins at play. Following this, hop aboard a modern 4WD vehicles and discover the Stockton Bright sand dunes, the last great sand dune system in New South Wales with its 32 kilometers of rolling sandy slopes. Here, you'll also have the opportunity to try your hand at san-boarding, an active experience that you simply won't forget. The tour then returns to Sydney in the early evening

2) Canberra Explorer – Australia's Capital (S11) {Dep. 8.30am Ret 9.15pm} (Dep : Every Mon, Wed, Fri & Sun)

Enjoy this comprehensive tour of Australia's national capital Canberra, a city designed to reflect an entire nation. Standing as a symbol of the nation's prosperity, you can take in all of the highlight attraction of this modern city. See contemporary architecture set cleverly amid Canberra's many delightful gardens and parkas. View the famous Lake Burley-Griffin and enjoy a guided tour through Parliament House and the renowned National Museum. Then view the foreign embassies, where many of the country's important dignitaries of World War I and II. On this full-day tour you'll also visit the impressive War Memorial and travel to the summit of Mt Ainslie, where extensive views out over the city and its surrounding landscapes await.

3) BLUE MOUNTAINS AND AUSTRALIAN WILDLIFE (S15) {Daily Dep. 8.40am Ret 5.30pm}

Travel west beyond the suburban sprawl of Sydney into the rugged beauty of the World Heritage-listed **Blue Mountain's National Park**. See magnificent steep valleys, canyons and the Tree Sisters on the Skyway, Scenic Railway or Cableway(own expense). Enjoy a morning break in the quaint township of Leura and listen to ancient Aboriginal Dreamtime legends before arriving at Echo Point to view the **Three Sisters**. Enjoy a stop at Govett's Leap and have the opportunity to enjoy the Fairfax Heritage Walk. Visit an Australia Wildlife Park with an opportunity to touch a cuddly koala and see kangaroos, wombats, dingoes and other unique Australia animals in this natural setting.

DAY 04: SYDNEY ✈ MELBOURNE

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, transfer to Sydney Domestic Airport for your flight to Melbourne. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel base on seat-in coach. In the afternoon. Proceed to your Melbourne City Tour as follow :-

City Sights and Dandenong Ranges (M2) {Dep. 1.30pm Ret. 5.30pm}

Discover contrasts of Melbourne: bushland and city sights Dominating Melbourne's eastern horizon, the blue hue of the Dandenong Ranges promises visitors picturesque mountainside forest, cool fern gullies, charming villages and breathtaking views. Immerse yourself in the natural beauty and delightful birdlife of Sherbrooke Forest. Enjoy city highlights before traveling east to the Dandenong Ranges. See the highlights of the city of Melbourne. Travel past Flinders Street Station's Paul's Cathedral, Old Melbourne Gaol and Queen Victoria Market. See Chinatown, the Flagstaff and Fitzroy Gardens and Kings Domain. Stop for a photo opportunity at Shrine of Remembrance. Travel through the trendy suburbs of South Yarra and Toorak. Look out for kookaburras and bell birds, colourful crimson rosella and king parrots. Hand feed the colourful rosella birds inhabiting Sherbrooke Forest(seed provided). Enjoy the meandering drive that leads through lush forest of tall trees and hilltop villages. Relish the spectacular vista from the Dandenongs Lookout.



DAY 05: MELBOURNE

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at own leisure till you depart for the below tour from 1;30pm to 10:30pm. Your tour will start with a visit Warrook Cattle Farm, a working cattle property, and enjoy the opportunity to feed kangaroos and other farm animals. At Phillip Island visit the Koala Conservation Centre and see koalas along an elevated boardwalk. View the Nobbies, home to one of Australia's largest fur seal populations. See the seaside town of Cowes and the Visitors Information Centre. At dusk, enjoy the "Penguin Parade" and see penguins make their way to their burrows.



DAY 06: MELBOURNE

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, you would proceed for the **The Great Ocean Road Adventure** which depart from 8:15am and return*approx 8.30pm. Today,Enjoy one of the world's great coastal drives with dramatic scenery, striking contrasts and magnificent vistas around every corner. Admire views of the Melbourne skyline and Port Phillip Bay from the West Gate Bridge. See the pretty seaside town of Lorne and the surfacing mecca of Torquay, home to some of Victoria's magnificent surf beaches, including the world-famous Bells Beach which hosts the Esther Surfacing Classic and offer year-round waves. Discover the legends of the 'The Shipwreck Coast' at Port Campbell National Park. See the spectacular **Twelve Apostles**, sandstone pillars that face the raging **Southern Ocean**, as well as **Loch Ard Gorge** and the famous rocky span of London Bridge.
